**November Ballot Measures:**

- **Measure WW—East Bay Regional Park District's bond extension measure:** Extends existing east bay regional park district bond with no increase in tax rate
  - East Bay Regional Park District Ambassador, Colin Coffey, will speak about Measure WW.
- **Measure T—City of Richmond Manufacturing Business License Tax:** Shall the Richmond Business License Act be adopted effective January 1, 2009, to define the category of Manufacturer and to establish a license fee equal to one fourth of one percent (0.25%) of the value of the material used in the manufacturing process during the immediately preceding calendar year for large manufacturers, be adopted?
  - **Speaking in favor of Measure T:** Marilyn Langlois
  - **Speaking in opposition of Measure T:** Kristine Hunt of the Contra Costa Tax Association
- **Proposition 7**—Requires government-owned utilities to generate 20% of their electricity from renewable energy by 2010, a standard currently applicable to private electrical corporations. Raises requirement for all utilities to 40% by 2020 and 50% by 2025.
  - **Speakers in favor of and in opposition to have not yet been confirmed**
