Marina Bay South Shoreline Bay Trail Reconstruction Project

August thru October, 2011

The Richmond Community Redevelopment Agency is pleased to announce the start of work on the **Marina Bay South Shoreline Bay Trail Reconstruction project**. As shown on the figure below, the work involves widening and repair of the existing paved Bay Trail between **Shimada Park** and **Meeker Slough**. Improvements include addition of a 4-foot wide decomposed granite shoulder along the inboard edge of the paved trail, upgrade of trail lighting and irrigation systems, and new landscaping.

Construction is scheduled to begin in early **August** with completion anticipated by the end of **October, 2011**. The existing pathway from Shimada Park to Meeker Slough will be closed intermittently during the trail reconstruction work. Signs indicating detour routes for pedestrians and bicyclists during periods of closure will be in place before work begins. Portions of Shimada Park parking lot will also be closed during construction to accommodate staging of materials and construction equipment.

Notice of closure periods will be posted at locations on site and provided to the Marina Bay Neighborhood Councils approximately two weeks prior to a closure. Project work hours are **8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday**. The contractor has been instructed to minimize dust, noise, and any other inconveniences to trail users and adjacent residences during the construction period.
